Those in need of urgent supplies, delivery of essential shopping, posting mail or simply wanting a prayer or conversation over the phone are invited to contact the Circuit office on the same number and email as above. We plan to distribute postcards with this information to those who might find themselves shut in or isolated. We would value any offers of help to support this work: please let the Circuit Office know if you are able to help.

5. We are asking for everyone to keep in phone/email/social media contact with one another to encourage support and prayer. Your Ministers and the Circuit Staff continue to be available for phone conversations to offer pastoral support and prayer. One particular initiative has been suggested by one of our Circuit members: We are invited wherever we are at 12 noon each day to spend time in prayer for everyone affected by this virus and for those who are seeking to care for others.
