This Sunday we are asked to pray for all those who attend Edmonton Methodist Church in our circuit.

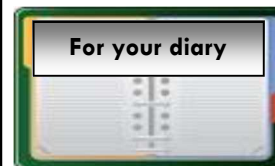

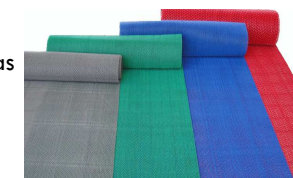
Easter Nests
