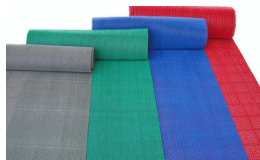

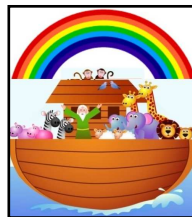
Including Gift Aid,
