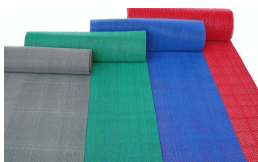




CARPET FUND

The carpet fund remains open, so let's try and reach the £3,500 target without Gift Aid!

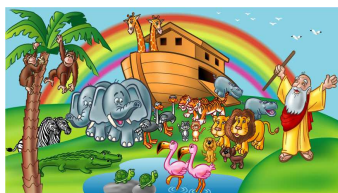
