



The Roof Repair Fund

Temporary roof repairs have now been undertaken, and we hope the sound system and associated electrical equipment is now risk-free for the time being. But the word 'temporary' means just that. The work done, funded with the help of a Circuit Grant, will last only a couple of years.

And so we need to think seriously about how to raise the £60k needed to undertake complete repairs. We have begun making enquiries about sources of funding beyond the Circuit, and will progress these over the coming months. But one thing is clear - we will need to demonstrate how we have made great efforts to raise funds ourselves.

We've made a good start, with over £800 raised so far, but we have a long way to go. So, please consider making a donation.

And if you can Gift Aid your donation, using the envelopes provided in the lobby, so much the better! Thank you.

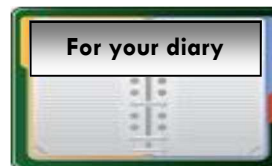
