Stalls, Workshops & Presentations by specialists on Violent Crime, Parenting, Finance, Mental Health & Well-Being Sport Activities & much more.

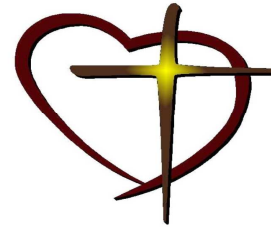
Please do come along and bring the family.

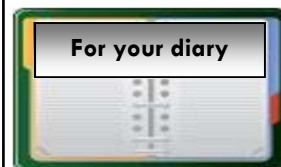
